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

SUBJECT: Class Deviation—Temporary Postponement of the Requirement for
Debarring and Suspending Officials to Enter Data on an Administrative
Agreement in the Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information
System.

The final rule for implementation of the Federal Awardee Performance and
Integrity Information System (FAPIIS) is effective April 22, 2010 (75 FR 14059).
However, debarring and suspending officials shall temporarily not enter the information
regarding administrative agreements into FAPIIS, as required by FAR 9.406-3(f) and
9.407-3(e), until further notice. We anticipate that the template for storage of this data
will be incorporated into FAPIIS by the fall of 2010.

This class deviation remains in effect until rescinded. I will notify you when the
