SUBJECT: Release of Procurement Data Standard Version 2.7

The Procurement Data Standard (PDS) provides the required data structure for distributing contract actions in accordance with Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement 204.201. The PDS Version 2.7 has been published and is available at the Contracting eBusiness webpage: <https://www.acq.osd.mil/asda/dpc/ce/ds/procurement-data-standard.html>

PDS Version 2.7 provides new capability to transact the Standard Line of Accounting (SLOA) as discrete, segmented data elements. PDS Version 2.7 also provides a new mechanism to trace clause applicability to line items on hybrid contracts, among other updates. For a complete listing of all updates, the PDS Version 2.7 Change Log is available at the link provided above. Defense Pricing and Contracting will coordinate the implementation of PDS Version 2.7 through the monthly In Process Review meetings with Components.
