SUBJECT: Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information System Integrates with the System for Award Management

On December 12, 2022, the Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information System (FAPIIS.gov) integrated with System for Award Management (SAM.gov) as part the ongoing Integrated Award Environment modernization, managed by the General Services Administration. Once integrated with SAM, the integrity records previously available in FAPIIS.gov will be renamed Responsibility/Qualification (R/Q) and will be a part of the entity information domain in SAM. This will provide users with a single access point for information about entity management, exclusions, and R/Q.

To search and view public R/Q information, Department of Defense users need to sign in to their SAM.gov account tied to their government email address. A role is not required. Some entity information will not be publically available and only visible to government users and non-government users with a role with the entity itself. Users can download a report from SAM showing the entity's basic identification information as well as the entity's R/Q information. Additionally, R/Q and proceedings data is available via a new Entity Management application program interface (API) at <https://open.gsa.gov/api/entity-api/>.

Government personnel will continue to enter required data (e.g., non-responsibility determination, termination for default) into FAPIIS via the input module in the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) at <https://www.cpars.gov/>.
