SUBJECT: Safeguarding Unclassified Controlled Technical Information Clause Compliance  
Scorecard - Second Quarter Fiscal Year 2015

In Better Buying Power 3.0 is the initiative to ensure cybersecurity of our networks and systems. Key to meeting this objective is the protection of unclassified controlled technical information. The Second Quarter Fiscal Year 2015 Clause Compliance Scorecard for DFARS Clause 252.204-7012, Safeguarding Unclassified Controlled Technical Information, is attached. I appreciate the effort of agencies that have improved their compliance. DPAP continues to work in collaboration with the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Systems Engineering (DASD(SE)) and the Office of the Deputy DoD Chief Information Officer for Cybersecurity to ensure effective implementation of this requirement and to further our objective of safeguarding unclassified DoD information within contractor information systems. In February 2015, DASD(SE) released "Guidance to Requiring Activities for Implementing DFARS Clause 252.204-7012 (Safeguarding Unclassified Controlled Technical Information)" (<http://www.acq.osd.mil/se/docs/DFARS-guide.pdf>).
