SUBJECT: Past Performance Information Retrieval System – Statistical Reporting

I am pleased to announce an update to the Past Performance Information Retrieval System – Statistical Reporting (PPIRS-SR). PPIRS-SR assists acquisition officials by providing objective, statistical performance information for low dollar value contracts.

Currently, PPIRS-SR collects quality and delivery data from numerous Department of Defense (DoD) databases, aggregates that data using algorithms, and provides the user with an objective rating of a contractor's prior performance. With this release, PPIRS-SR provides acquisition officials with new procurement analysis capabilities. Acquisition officials with solicitation level access may now see and use the additional PPIRS-SR capabilities at <https://www.ppirs.gov>. Training is available at <https://www.ppirs.gov/webtrain.htm>.

The Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) was revised on May 26, 2015 (DFARS case 2014-D015), and will be updated as additional capabilities are added to PPIRS-SR. New capabilities currently under development for the next release will contain a Predictive Analytic capability that will enable PPIRS-SR to predict the probability of a supplier introducing counterfeit and nonconforming material into the DoD supply chain.
