SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 3rd Quarter FY 2014


Contractor past performance reporting is a focus of the Office of Federal Procurement Policy (OFPP) and is of importance to the USD(AT&L). I am tasked with monitoring and communicating how the Department is performing on a quarterly basis. The DoD goal for FY14 is 95%.

The attached spreadsheet identifies the Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) compliance metrics as of July 7, 2014, and compares the FY14 second quarter data of 83.19% against the third quarter data of 80.33%. The overall decrease in DoD's compliance can be attributed to the implementation effective July 1, 2014, of Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) merge.

Information from the Construction Contractor Appraisal Support System and the Architect-Engineer Contract Administration Support System are now included in CPARS. The PPIRS compliance metrics were adjusted in accordance with this merge and A&E and construction contract evaluations will now be done on an annual basis. Due dates for contract performance longer than one year in duration are no longer calculated at 120 days after completion date/revised completion date but based on the award date and 485 days.

The "Guidance for the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS)" dated July 2014, was updated to reflect the changes and is available on the CPARS website at <https://www.cpars.gov/cparsfiles/pdfs/CPARS-guidance.pdf>.
