Mr. Garry Shafovaloff is the Site Director, Office of Human Capital Initiatives, Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment (A&S). He supports the A&S leadership and DoD component stakeholders on human capital strategic planning, policy, programs and initiatives for the 185,000 members of the defense acquisition workforce. He provides management of the Defense Acquisition Workforce Development Account fund which has been used across DoD components to rebuild and continuously improve the defense acquisition workforce.
