Total U.S. Security Assistance Committed Since Russia's Full-Scale Invasion on February 24, 2022



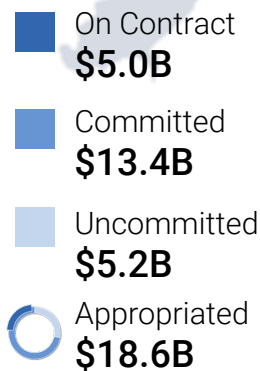

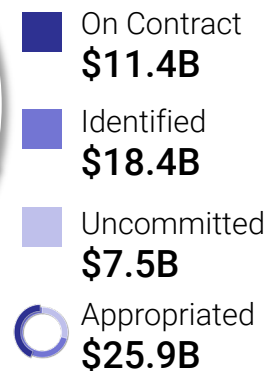


Ukraine Presidential Drawdown Replenishment
